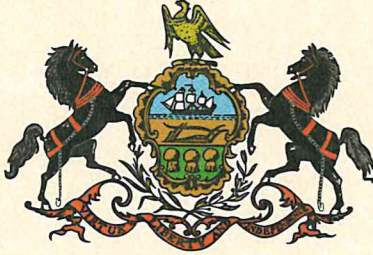

Citation

Whereas, The House of Representatives of Pennsylvania is recognizing June 28, 2021, as National Logistics Day in Pennsylvania; and

Whereas, The logistics industry, which includes the packaging, warehousing and shipping of goods, is an important industry in state, national and global economies and is responsible for the shipping of goods via air, truck, rail and sea. Shipments can be delivered across town or to countries throughout the world. Whether it is delivering raw products to a manufacturer, finished products to a retailer or newly purchased products to the front door of a consumer, no deliveries could occur without logistics. The third-party logistics industry represents an eight-hundred-billion-dollar industry in the United States; and

Whereas, This Commonwealth plays a major role in the logistics industry due to its sixty-five operating railroads with trains traveling on more than five thousand miles of track. Pennsylvania moves more than seventy million tons of goods through the ports of Erie, Philadelphia and Pittsburgh and is home to five international airports and nearly two thousand miles of interstate highway. Goods need to be transported to the consumer by truck, rail, air or sea regardless of whether the business is a small family operation or a corporation operating globally. A business cannot succeed without a strong logistics system in place.

Now therefore, the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania joins with all residents of this Commonwealth in observing National Logistics Day;
