



Certified Transportation Broker (CTB) Program Honor Statement

I acknowledge that I have read and understood the following CTB Honor Statement:

The Transportation Intermediaries Association prides itself on a strong code of ethics and will not tolerate unethical behavior from individuals enrolled in the Associations' programs. Every individual, simply by enrolling in the CTB program, is honor-bound to refrain from cheating. This includes using books or notes while taking the CTB exam as well as discussing the exam with others while you are answering exam questions.

If it is suspected that an examinee cheated on the CTB exam, they will be notified in writing or by telephone and will be given the chance to respond. TIA will review all information and make a decision. If a registrant is caught cheating on the exam they will be banned from the CTB program for five (5) years. There will be no refund of fees and no financial credits extended. If an individual is suspended for cheating but had previously passed one or two of the exam sections, their previous exam credits will no longer be valid, and they will have to begin the full CTB process again after completing their five year suspension.

Any behavior that compromises the integrity of the CTB designation will not be tolerated by TIA.
