### What are we looking for in an article for publication?

For 3PL Perspectives, TIA looks for articles to be informative rather than advertorial. The article should represent a current issue, trend, or tip to help members of the organization better understand the state of the Logistics Industry. Articles should be between 800-1200 Words in length.

# What to expect with getting published?

TIA works 2 months in advance for 3PL Perspectives. This means that once an article is submitted, it will be able to be run in the Issue 2 months after it being turned in. Any edits made to the article aside from grammatical errors will be sent back to the author for their approval. Issues will go out on the first Monday of every month. A digital copy will also be posted to our website.

## Can I add pictures/images to my article?

Images are welcome to be added into the author's article. Please send the image as a PNG or JPEG instead of in the article to ensure that it stays in it's highest quality. Please send us who the artist/photographer of the image is so we can properly credit them in the publication. If you do not wish to submit a picture/image, TIA will select a stock image from our database for your article.
